

Opportunity for exhibition assistant at Swansea Museum

We have a great opportunity for someone who would like represent Mencap and the Hidden Now Heard Project at our local exhibition in Swansea Museum. If you have good communication skills, and would enjoy helping us share our project with the public and community, we would like to hear from you.

Mencap's Hidden Now Heard project is collecting the stories of 80 people connected to 6 former long-stay hospital sites across Wales. The first hospital we have researched is Hensol Hospital and on January 20 we will be launching our exhibition on Hensol at Swansea Museum, this exhibition will run until February 28. The exhibition will enable us to help put learning disability history issues at the forefront of people's minds.

The role will involve working alongside other volunteers, presenting our exhibition to the public and visitors, discussing themes with them and assisting with the launch activities of the exhibition. The exhibition will be open on a weekly basis, Tuesday to Sunday between the hours of 10am and 5pm. We hope that you would be able to volunteer for a few hours each week - the exact times and days can be based on your availability.
