

Betsy Cadwaladyr would have been remarkable in any age; in the nineteenth century her adventurous life - she travelled the world and worked as a nurse at the Balaclava military hospital during the Crimean War - was truly extraordinary. Her name has since been used for the largest health organisation in Wales and her life story is taught in Welsh schools.

Her autobiography was first published in 1857, Honno Press are brought it back into print in 1986 and have now published a new edition which restores important elements of the original version and adds new material. The new edition will reflect Betsy's importance in the history of the women of Wales.
